AGENCY SHARING

MPIC

Carol updated partners on the last Employer Services Meeting. Announced Mental Health is an approved State site for work experience and situational assessments. MPIC's work experience will open up next month (July). Currently work experience is just open for dislocated workers.

Experience Works

Don reported that the State Director, Clayton Thomas, will be dropping in tomorrow (7/19) to tour the One-Stop Centers. Current enrollment for work experience is 12.

Goodwill

Robert reported that the agency audit is coming up. Staff changes: Dina has moved on; Amy will be working out of the Willits office; Robert in Fort Bragg and Ukiah. A full-time position is open in Fort Bragg at \$12.50 per hour for an Employer Services Specialist.

EDD

Lorraine reported that cubicles are in place, file cabinets have arrived, and consolidation of the supply room is taking place. Budget cuts are affecting all agencies.

JA

Hiring freeze still in effect for Mendocino County and budget cuts have occurred.

Moving Concerns/Updates
